

PALLISER REGIONAL SCHOOLS JURISDICTION PROFILE

Palliser Regional Schools is a traditionally rural school jurisdiction located in southern Alberta. The geographical area stretches from just south of Lethbridge to the Bow River and Siksika Reserve in the north. Palliser Centre houses the Central Office Administration, Maintenance and Transportation and is located in the City of Lethbridge. In addition, a satellite Maintenance Shop has been set up in the Town of Vulcan. The division offers full public education services to approximately 6,600 students Preschool through Grade 12. As of the 2010-2011 school year, Palliser has 15 community schools, 16 Hutterian colony schools, eight Christian alternative schools, seven of which are in Calgary on five different campuses, four outreach programs and two Low German Mennonite alternative programs.
