Literacy & Numeracy Annual Report 2022-2023

2022-2023 Highlights

- In alignment with our Literacy Framework, we have continued to facilitate numerous professional learning opportunities around literacy that emphasize early literacy and language support, content area literacy, vocabulary, and comprehension.
- We have continued strong partnerships with local universities to expand professional learning opportunities in both literacy and numeracy.
- We developed an early language and literacy assessment and provided professional development to teachers utilizing the assessment.
- Teachers and administrators from across Palliser will participate in a division-wide literacy and numeracy symposia in May.
- > We held numerous professional learning opportunities during division-wide collaborative days and additional opportunities to support curriculum implementation.
- We developed a Palliser Literacy Assurance Model to better support our division-wide use of research-based assessments and interventions.
- Additional literacy and numeracy support and intervention were provided to 317 students in Grade 1, 249 students in Grade 2, 81 students in Grade 3, and 98 students in Grade 4.
- Palliser students from Grades 1 to 4 have demonstrated significant growth in early reading and numeracy measures included below.
- In addition to the mandatory curriculum implementation of Grades 1-3 English Language Arts and Mathematics, we had two schools that optionally implemented Grades 4-6 English Language Arts and Mathematics.

2023-2024 Key Actions

- We will continue to support schools with implementation of the Palliser Literacy Framework with a focus on key areas of literacy: Oral Language, Disciplinary Literacy, Balanced Literacy, and Digital Literacy.
- We will continue to support schools with implementation of the Palliser Numeracy Framework with a focus on key areas of numeracy: number sense and fluency, mathematical reasoning, visual mathematics, problem solving, and rich tasks.
- > We will create a Palliser Numeracy Assurance Model to support schools with numeracy assessment and intervention.
- We will develop a continuum of writing assessment to support our collective understanding of writing development.
- > We will create opportunities to share and celebrate literacy and numeracy learning.





Leadership

We have supported professional learning over this school year for administrators with curriculum implementation and specifically with leading change to support literacy, numeracy, assessment, and Indigenization. We have engaged experts in these areas to support our leaders in developing this professional learning. We have routinely engaged administrators in dialogue on how we progress with curriculum implementation and plan to administer a needs assessment for all administrators to support future professional learning.

Professional Learning

We have continued our support for professional learning for all staff through numerous professional learning opportunities. This year, our staff have attended over 70 division-wide professional learning communities geared towards supporting literacy, numeracy, and assessment and over 65 individual events related to literacy, numeracy, and assessment.

In regards to curriculum implementation, we have a number of collaborative opportunities that we are facilitating over April and May to further support curriculum implementation. We plan to administer a needs assessment for all teachers to support curriculum implementation and future professional learning.

Challenges

We receive varied feedback on the utility of approved assessments Grades 1 to 3 mandatory provincial assessments, and we are continuing to offer schools flexibility and training for the multitude of approved assessments being utilized. In terms of expected implementation of Grades 4 to 6 English Language Arts and Mathematics and Grades 1 to 3 Science, we have received feedback from teachers with a concern about a lack of resources aligned with the new curricula and time to understand and prepare for changes.






Literacy Assessment Trends

Grade 1-4 Reading Achievement








Numeracy Assessment Trends

Provincial Numeracy Screening Assessment: Grades 1 - 3 2019 Students


Grade 1 Numeracy Assessment Component Performance








Grade 2 Numeracy Assessment Component Performance
