HIGHLIGHTS

The Palliser senior leadership team met to review comprehensive planning for the next school year and efforts to ensure cohesive operations across the division. To round out the month, the Superintendent participated in a trade mission to Colombia, exploring international educational partnerships and opportunities.

As the school year winds down, more student achievements will be celebrated, including grade 12 graduations, elementary farewells and the conclusion of the 2024-2025 program at the Prairie Winds Fire and Emergency Services Academy. Background

The Board of Trustees is committed to providing high-quality education and fostering a supportive learning environment for all students. The development of a comprehensive strategic plan is essential to guide the division's priorities, resource allocation, and accountability over the next four years. The Five Year Strategic Plan has been developed through an extensive and collaborative process, including input from stakeholders such as students, parents, staff, community members, and educational societies. Background

Superintendent Driscoll has received a letter of gratitude from the Terry Fox Foundation acknowledging the generosity of Palliser Schools in support of the 2024 Terry Fox School Run. Twenty-five Palliser schools raised \$18,255.37 for the Foundation in support of cancer research.

The division wishes to highlight the efforts of Vulcan Prairieview Elementary School for being recognized by the Foundation as having reached “Top Fundraising” status in Alberta for 2024, making the list as one of the top 25 fundraising elementary schools in the province. Vulcan Prairieview students have participated in Terry Fox School Runs for 22 years.
