Supporting Student Wellbeing

The Board reviewed the Wellbeing Board Report, which highlights Palliser's commitment to helping every student thrive in all areas of wellness: social, emotional, physical, and mental. The division's Continuum of Support ensures that students receive the right help at the right time through three levels of service: universal, targeted, and specialized supports.

Key priorities include:

- Teaching & Learning: Embedding Social Emotional Learning in classrooms, supporting the new wellness curriculum, continuing the CASA classroom at R.I. Baker, and offering targeted programming through Mental Health Workers.
- Belonging & Relationships: Promoting inclusion and belonging, offering trauma-informed practice training for staff, and ensuring every student has a trusted adult at school.
- Policy & Voice: Updating wellness plans to include Indigenous ways of knowing, piloting a new student voice survey, and developing systems to track behavioural trends.
- Partnerships: Strengthening collaboration with partners such as Woods Homes, Impact Parenting, Dr. Kendra Massie, and the University of Calgary, and continuing student leadership initiatives like Headstrong.
